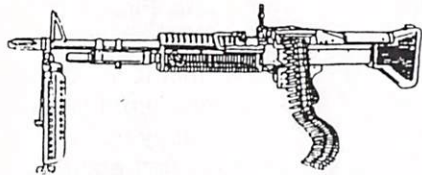

EASY TO JOIN. If you served in Vietnam or Thailand as an Air/Security Policeman or augmentee from 1959 to 1975 you are eligible to join the VSPA. Here's all you need to do:

- 1) Fill out the Application/Data Sheet with all the information that you are willing to share with fellow members. Please Print Clearly.
- 2) Enclose a COPY of your DD214. The copy will go into the VSPA archives and not returned.
- 3) Dues are still just \$10. per year and are renewable on January 1st of each year. If you join after July 1st add an additional dollar for each remaining month that year.
- 4) Make check or money order out to the VIETNAM SECURITY POLICE ASSOCIATION and mail along with application and DD214 to;
