Note: On or about September 22, 1970 I stepped on a Land Mine. This is what cut my stay short in Vietnam. I even had my orders for Mcguire AFB,NJ when my time was up. As you can see by my DD 214 I was put on temporary Disability list on September 14, 1970 & because of all the problems I had and a series of operations on my Foot, the Air Force ultimately decided to retire me on March/1971 as you can see by my Discharge Certificate a copy of which is enclosed.

I served in Tiger Flight when I first went over & then was transferred to base patrol of which I served until I left.

I would really love to get in contact with any of the guys of which I served with during the time I served in Vietnam, however because of time and a Senior moment I cannot remember any of the names.
