In regards to the application of Daniel E. Odom for membership in the VSPA on the basis of his work as a Security Police Dog Handler at Korat RTAFB, Thailand between Dec 1974 and Dec 1975.

Odom provided a DD-214 verifying his Air Force service as an 81150A, and "Indochina or Korea Service." However, his Thailand service was after the period for which the Vietnam Service Medal was awarded.

I asked VSPA member Mike Diercks, who is also Korat Unit Director for the Vietnam Dog Handlers Association, to call Odom and question him about his work at Korat. Mike spoke with Odom at length on the phone, and reported to me on 8/30/08 that in his opinion Odom knew enough details of the kennels, dogs and posts at Korat to prove he had served there as he claims.

On the basis of the above-mentioned items of proof and information, I am granting VSPA membership to Daniel E. Odom. This letter will be attached to Odom's DD-214 in the VSPA membership files.
