## **LIFE MEMBERSHIPS**

Annual Dues are payable on the anniversary date of your membership and delinquent thereafter. Dues for a Life Membership never expire and are based upon the age of the current member or new applicant. A DD Form 214 is required for membership in the VSPA. Therefore, the DD214 will be used for proof of age.

Members who have paid their annual dues in advance will have those payments applied to the Life Membership dues. For example, if you are current member and are age 60, your dues for the current year (\$15) will be applied to the Life Membership fee of \$160 leaving a balance of \$145. If you have paid two or three years in advance, the dues for future years will also be applied.
